Hiring Our Heroes

- Service Members: The <u>Corporate Fellowship Program</u> is an innovative 12-week program that provides transitioning service members with professional training and hands-on experience in the civilian workforce.
- Military Spouses/Caregivers: Military Spouse Fellowship Program is a 12-week program that provides military spouses and caregivers with professional training, networking and hands-on experience in the civilian workforce. Military Spouse Career Accelerator Pilot is a 12-week fellowship connecting military spouses with ready-to-hire employers in a variety of locations and industries.
- <u>Salesforce Fellowship Program</u> allows transitioning service members and military spouses to participate in paid 12-week fellowships, gaining targeted experience as a certified Salesforce professional. The hands-on experience offered through the program prepares fellows for a smooth transition into Salesforce careers.
- Transitioning service members, and military spouses may participate in the <u>Skills-Based Fellowship Program</u> providing relevant workplace experience with upskilling in high-demand fields.

<u>Solar Ready Vets Fellowship Program</u>: Transitioning service members who are eligible to participate in the Hiring Our Heroes <u>Corporate Fellowship Program</u> and/or <u>Skills-Based Fellowship Program</u>, may match with Solar Energy Industry employers as part of a Department of Energy-funded grant. <u>U.S. Department of Labor Off-Base Transition Training</u>: Employment-focused training for veterans, including those veterans currently serving in the Reserve Component (National Guard and Reserve members), and their spouses. Free workshops in-person or online.

U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Education and Training

- Veteran Employment Through Technology Education Courses (VET TEC): gain computer experience to start or advance your

- The <u>Veteran Rapid Retraining Assistance Program (VRRAP)</u>: offers education and training for high-demand jobs to Veterans who are unemployed because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Keep reading to find out if you're eligible and how to apply.
